Understanding Cyber Security:

ATERING HOLE ATTACK

is a cyber attack technique in which a cybercriminal guesses and observes a user or organisation's often-use websites and infects them with malware.

How It Works



Find Target

A cybercriminal stalks an individual or group of people (usually within an organisation) to understand their behaviours and find out which are the websites they frequently visit.



Test & Inject

The cybercriminal will test on these regularly visited websites and try to inject it with exploit code. If the cybercriminal found there is a website that can be compromised, he or she is able to redirect the user to a site hosting the exploit code.



Malware Delivery

When the user visits the compromised website, the malicious code downloads in the background and runs a vulnerability scan on the victim's device. Once the vulnerability is found, the malware will deliver to the user's system.

Hide your online activities with a VPN and your browser's private browsing features, and block social media sites from your office network.



Update your Software

Check the software developer's website for any security patches and make sure your organisation's system is up to date.
