Create Strong Passwords

Choose strong passwords that consist of lower and uppercase letters, numbers and symbols, making it difficult for hackers to crack your password.



Do not download attachments from unknown senders

Refrain from downloading attachments and clicking on any links from senders you do not know.



Do not save your card details on your computer

Although convenient, it also enables others to access your card details easily if your computer got stolen or hacked into.



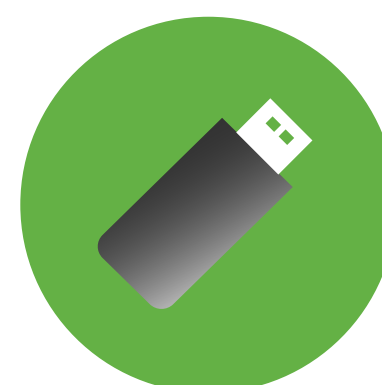
Avoid sending sensitive info to non-HTTPS pages

Malicious attackers can easily inject code into a non-HTTPS page that is hosting the login/payment forms, and your information can be stolen.



Cover your computer's webcam

Viruses and malware that steal information from your devices can embed software that can record whatever a webcam sees.



Do not plug in random USB sticks

You may risk having your computer be infected with viruses and malware if you simply plug in an unknown device out of curiosity.
